Day 4 Mirissa-Whale Watching and Kosgoda-Turtle Hatchery


Whale watching at Mirissa has been one of the most popular attraction among the tourists since the year 2009 and still we are operating whale watching tours based in Mirissa harbour. This point is the closest to blue whales inhabitation due to its appropriate environmental conditions. Last years reports show that five types of whales and four kinds of dolphins were seen.

Kosgoda-turtle hatchery

The turtle Hatchery shows Five species of turtles namely green turtles, hawksbill turtle, loggerheads, leatherbacks and olive ridley turtles. The eggs collected by the villagers and fishermen are purchased by this Hatchery and kept in sandy pens until hatched. The newly hatched ones are kept in seawater tanks and released into the sea during the night. This Hatchery has released more than 1,75,000 young turtles into the sea. An endowment by the Hasselbald Estate was responsible for the Establishment of this Hatchery.

Day 5 Bentota-Yala

Post breakfast leave for Yala. The Ruhunu National Park covers 126,786 hectares including the Strict Natural Reserve (Block II) The most familiar is Block I (14,101 hectares) and this was established in 1938.

Yala is known for its big herds and large number of elephants, leopards , spotted deer, Sambhur, crocodiles, wild mongoose, boar, wild buffalo and many other animals .More than 130 bird species are recorded which includes the resident and winter visitors. There are 7 Bungalows inside the park with Camp Sites

Day 6 Yala-Colombo

Post breakfast leave for Colombo. It is the business and commercial center and the new capital is Sri Jaywardhanapura Kotte, a few miles away. Colombo was only a small seaport which came into prominence in the 16th century with the arrival of the Portuguese in 1505 and its development as a major harbour took place during the British era. Colombo became the capital of Sri Lanka in 1815 after Kandyan Kingdom was ceded to the British. The remains of the buildings during the period of the Portuguese , Dutch and British rule are found in every area of the city.

None of the Portuguese and Dutch fortifications are found today but some of their buildings and churches could be seen in the Fort and Pettah areas. Visit Fort the former British administrative center and military garrison, Sea street, the goldsmith's quarters in the heart of Pettah, the Bazaar area where there is also a Hindu Temple with elaborate stone carvings, the Kayman's Gate with the Belfry at the original gate to enter the fort
